Postponements/Reschedules

If a team finds they need to postpone a match, they should contact the opposing team as early as possible to request the postponement. It is expected that the opposing team will attempt to be accommodating to this request, in order to avoid forfeits.

- At least one of the teams must inform Cindy of the postponement
- Failing to contact opposing team in reasonable time may result in forfeiture of match points
- Postponements must be made up **before** the last night of the session and must be played at the sponsor bar
- Teams failing to complete all matches will not be eligible for prize money

Other notes:

In the spirit of play, forfeited legs and matches should be avoided. However, if it can't be avoided, please be sure to follow these steps:

- Be sure to inform Cindy about the situation
- Whether it is an entire match, segment, or a few legs, each leg must be forfeited individually to make the score correct.
 - o Choose both players, start the leg normally
 - o Enter at least one score, doesn't matter what
 - o Click the X at the bottom left of the scoreboard
 - o Click Forfeit [name] for the player that is forfeiting the leg
 - o Repeat for each leg in each segment.

Post Session Tournament

At the end of each session - if there is at least 50% participation from that session's teams - there will be a Post Session Tournament.

- Regular session payouts and 1st place plates are not affected.
- All teams are eligible, but participation is voluntary. Cost is \$20/team.
- Alternates may pair up in order to participate.
- If one player from a team is unable to participate, it is acceptable for the remaining player to pair up with an alternate or another player in the same situation.
- In both of the above scenarios, both players' individual averages would make up their Team DCA Rating and the teams would have to be set a day or two before the tournament to allow time for seeding
- The purpose of these allowances is to increase participation
- Session's teams will be divided into two single-elimination brackets one for top half DCA Rating, one for bottom half DCA Rating.
- Each bracket will be seeded solely by Team DCA Rating.
- The format Doubles, best of 9 legs 501/501/cricket/cricket/starter calls remaining legs.
- Payout depth will depend on participation, but likely, the top 25%
